Description of Position:

This is a per-service position as Trombone III/Bass of the Mississippi Symphony Orchestra. Compensation is \$75.01* per service performed. There is a 40-service offer per season guarantee. This position does qualify for tenure and annual seniority increases after 2 completed seasons. This position does not reimburse for travel. Winning candidate will begin the position at the earliest mutually agreed date.

Applicant agrees to perform all MSO services as requested subject to the terms enumerated in the Master Agreement between the Jackson Federation of Musicians, Local 579 American Federation of Musicians and the Mississippi Symphony Orchestra Association.

The Mississippi Symphony Orchestra presents a 38-week season beginning September 1 and concluding May 31. The MSO is comprised of a full-time core of 27 musicians and supplemented as needed by local and regional musicians. The MSO rehearses and performs primarily on nights and weekends however there are some daytime orchestral educational services. Musicians of the MSO are covered under a collective bargaining agreement between the Jackson Federation of Musicians, Local 579 American Federation of Musicians and the Mississippi Symphony Orchestra Association.
