These are full-time or core positions in the Violin section of the MSO. Applicant agrees to perform all MSO services as requested subject to the terms enumerated in the Master Agreement between the Jackson Federation of Musicians, Local 579 American Federation of Musicians and the Mississippi Symphony Orchestra Association. Winning candidates will be eligible for tenure after the completion of 2 seasons. This position does not reimburse for travel. Candidate may also elect to pursue teaching in the String Instruction Program in the Jackson Public Schools administered by the MSO, subject to qualifications of the candidate and availability of teacher opening.
